AGREEMENT

This Agreement entered into on this day of in the year of the English calendar, between Shri., aged about years, son of Shri..... & Shrimati, aged about years, wife of Shri....., both resident of hereinafter called the Parents, (which expression shall mean and include their respective successors, legal representatives, permitted assigns, etc.) of the first part

AND

Indus Public School, Rohtak hereinafter called the School, (which expression shall mean and include its successors, legal representatives, permitted assigns, etc.) of the second part.

Whereas the Parents are desirous of seeking admission of their natural born child/legal ward (hereinafter called the Intending Student) in to the School; and whereas the School is agreeable to grant provisional admission to the Intending Student on terms and conditions, to which the Parents unconditionally & willingly agree, and both parties hereto wish to reduce the factum of this agreement in to writing.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS UNDER :

1. That the School has a policy to admit students purely based on merit without any caste, creed, religion, colour, ethnic background or sex, and; the students are required compulsorily to attend classes on all the religions, methodology, traditions, cultures, etc. for which the Parents have no objection and the Parents hereby give their unconditional and willing consent for all the above.
2. That the Parents agree that the internal grading, markings, reviewing, testing, examination, assessment system of the School is for the Student body as a whole and the Parents will not try to influence the same in favour of the Intending Student or any other Student and will not challenge the whole or part of the system at any platform including in any judicial forum/court and the decision of the School will be final, and the School has the exclusive right to improve/ change/discontinue the same from time to time, to which right the Parents agree.
3. That the Parents would like the Intending Student to get all round education including (but not limited to) theatres, singing, dancing, music, camping, trekking, games, sports, athletics, debates, electronics, computers etc. and the Parents would like the School to comply both modern & traditional teaching methods, and consequently the Parents agree that the School has exclusive right to employ any teaching method, techniques etc. which the School may feel necessary to prepare the Students for modern society while imbibing the Indian culture & traditions and the School may in its absolute discretion, change the teaching method, techniques etc. or the curriculum or the extra curricular activities in the interest of the Student body as a whole, for which changes/ improvements/ discontinuance, etc. the Parents hereby give their unconditional & willing consent.
4. That the Students of the School undertake a lot of activities, including (but not limited to) games, sports, gymnastics, boxing, wrestling, kabaddi, swimming, sailing, rafting, camping, trekking mountaineering, rock climbing, horse riding, obstacles courses, children park equipment, polo, chemistry/physics/biology/ electronics experiments, etc., which may be potentially hazardous & life threatening, and in which the School may require the Intending Student to compulsorily take part in and the Parents hereby give their unconditional & willing consent for the same with the full knowledge of the risks & possible adverse consequences and the Parents agree not to prefer any claim, demand for compensation, etc. against the School on this or any other account.
5. That the School will not be held responsible for any physical or mental injury, stress, agony, etc., or for any loss of limb or life, which may occur while the Intending Student is coming to or going from the School, or on the campus of School, or undertaking any of the aforementioned activities, etc. at preceding paragraphs, which may be caused by another student or member of staff or the School or by any other outsider. In such an eventuality, the Parents will be free to initiate any action against the erring individual, for which the School may provide assistance.
6. That the Parents declare and confirm that the Intending Student does not suffer from any mental, physical or sensory disability and the Parents hereby authorise the School to subject the Intending Student to medical examinations from time to time and the Parents hereby give their unconditional consent to the School and its staff to initiate/ authorise etc., in good faith, any emergency surgery, emergency/routine medical procedure etc. which may be necessitated at or outside the campus of the School and the Parents agree that they shall not hold the School or its staff responsible for any adverse consequences (like loss of limb, loss of life, etc.)
7. That if at any time the situation emerges which requires that the Intending Student is unable to participate in any such hazardous or potentially life threatening activity as mentioned above, and notwithstanding any intimation which may have been or may hereafter be provided by the Parents or any medical authority, it will be the onus of the Parents to withdraw the Intending Student forthwith or ensure that the Intending Student does not participate in any such activity or situation. The Parents are aware that the School encourages leadership skills in its Students and the School Students are responsible for administration of majority of such hazardous or life threatening activities, and the Parents understand & agree that the School or its Students cannot & will not be held responsible for the Intending Student taking part of his own freewill, in any such activity and any eventuality emerging consequently, and the Parents will not prefer any claim, demand for compensation etc. in such eventuality.

8. That the School forbids the possession or use of alcohol, narcotics, intoxicants, tobacco etc. and also forbids acts of sex amongst Students and the Parents agree, and hereby grant to the School the exclusive & unhindered right to expel the Intending Student if he is found in possession of or making use of such forbidden substance, or is involved in an act of indiscipline, or moral turpitude or aggression or misconduct or in romance or any other such act, deed or situation which is socially unacceptable/ undesirable/objectionable etc., or if the Intending Student contracts a curable, incurable communicable disease (like STD, AIDS, etc.), or is involved in an act, deed or situation which is objectionable or undesirable to the School authorities (or the Student Body), then the School will have full right to expel the Intending Student to which right the Parents unconditionally & willingly agree, and decision of the School in this regard will be final.
9. That the Intending Student is the natural born child/legal ward of Parents and no custody proceedings are pending in any court of law & the Parents hereby indemnify the School on this account and the Parents hereby agree to keep the School indemnified on this account, and that if any third party claims any right, interest etc., in the Intending Student or prefers any legal or other action against the School (based on any right, interest etc., or acting on behalf of the Intending Students) then the Parents shall be personally (jointly & severally) responsible for the same & hereby agree to make good/ reimburse to the School any amounts, etc. that may be awarded by a competent court of law.
10. That timely payment of all dues, charges, etc. is an essential part of this agreement and the Parents agree that the School reserves the exclusive right to expel the Intending Student in case, the dues, charges etc. are not paid prior to the scheduled dates or when demanded, and the Parents agree that the School reserves the exclusive right to increase the fees, charges, etc. at least once a year, and the School reserves the exclusive right to charge additional fees, charges, etc. for any new activity, new teaching method, etc.
11. That the Parents are aware that if they did not waive their rights against the School as mentioned above; the annual, monthly and other charges of the School will be substantially higher to cover for financial risk of such liability of such potential claims etc. and the Parents are deriving direct financial gain by waiving the rights as mentioned & agreed to herein and the Parents agree that an increase in fees, charges, etc. as mentioned above is not any ground for restitution of rights waived hereunder, and that the Parents agree that if they would like to retribute any such right, the Parents shall pay to School, a sum of rupees ten lacs or such enhanced amount as may be necessary to cover risk for the Intending Student/Student body as a whole for restitution of rights at least ninety days prior to the date from which the Parents desire restitution of any right waived hereunder, during which period the School will enjoy all rights hereunder including the right to expel the Intending Student. The waiver of rights herein does not absolve any member of the staff of the School of any act of willful negligence or misconduct in their individual capacity in which eventuality the Parents will not hold the School responsible, but will be free to initiate any action against erring staff member in his individual capacity.
12. That upon the Parents having read, understood & unconditionally agreeing to the prospectus, rules & regulations, and also agreeing to waive their rights as above and also unconditionally agreeing to all the above terms & conditions, the School agrees to give provisional admission to the Intending Student.
13. That singular includes the plural and the masculine gender includes the feminine gender & vice versa, unless repugnant to the context.
14. That should any dispute or difference arise out of, or concerning the subject matter of this agreement, except in respect of the matters hereby otherwise provided for, the same shall be referred to the sole arbitration of a retired defence officer or a retired government servant or a qualified advocate appointed by both the parties as mutually agreed upon and the decision of such arbitrator shall be conclusive and binding on the parties hereto, if the proceedings & award is not contrary to the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
15. That irrespective of the place of signing this agreement, the place of performance & and jurisdiction of this agreement shall be the court of **local judicial magistrate**, and courts superior to it.
16. That this agreement shall remain in force till the Intending Student passes final class or till the Intending Student is withdrawn from the School or till the Intending Student is expelled from the School, which ever event happens first.
