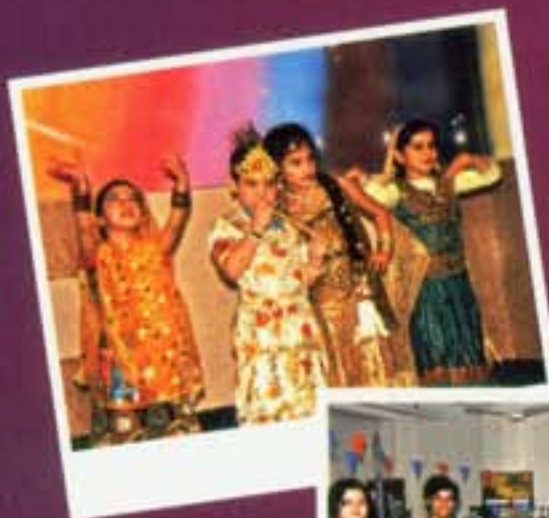

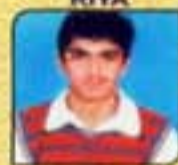

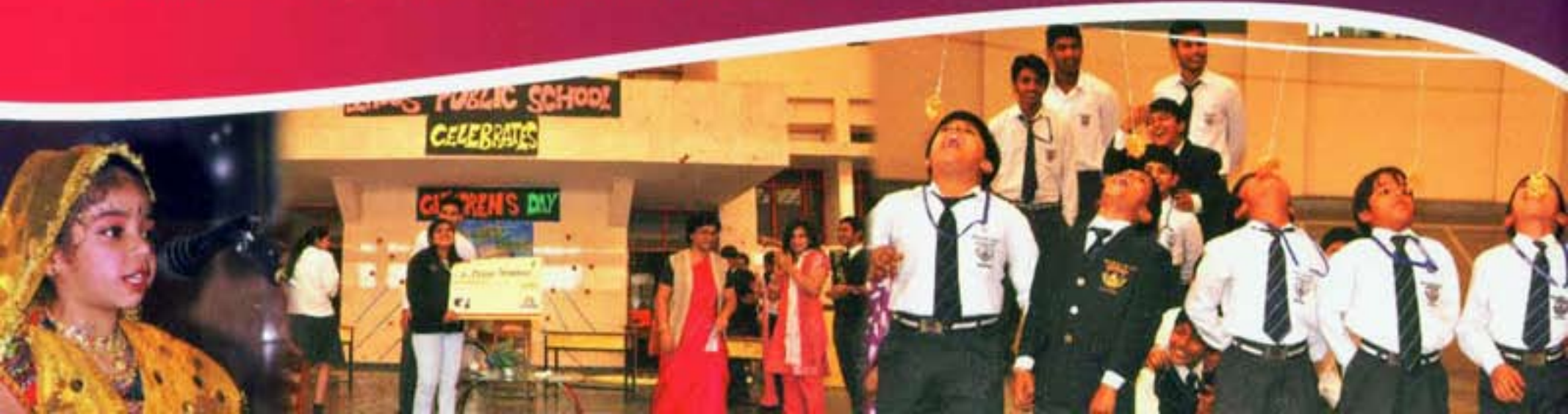
Summer Bonanza

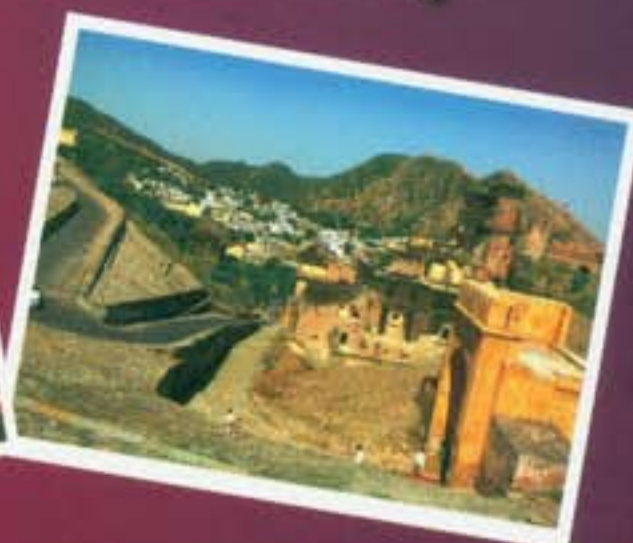
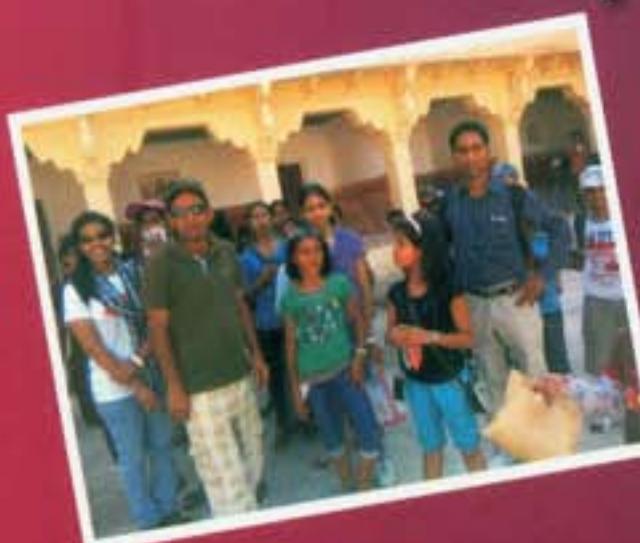
